

Case Report Guidelines

1. Presentation of Case (about 200 words)

Describe the nature of the case. Cases may be purely clinical, and may focus on unusual presentations of well-known diseases or presentation of rare diseases. Alternatively, cases may involve descriptions of innovations, quality improvement-related issues or medical errors.

2. Management (about 300 words)

A description of how the case was managed, including drugs prescribed, technology used, etc.

3. Conclusion (about 100 words)

A succinct description of what readers can learn from this case.

* All submissions must be accompanied by an image relating to the case.
